Netherlands Flag



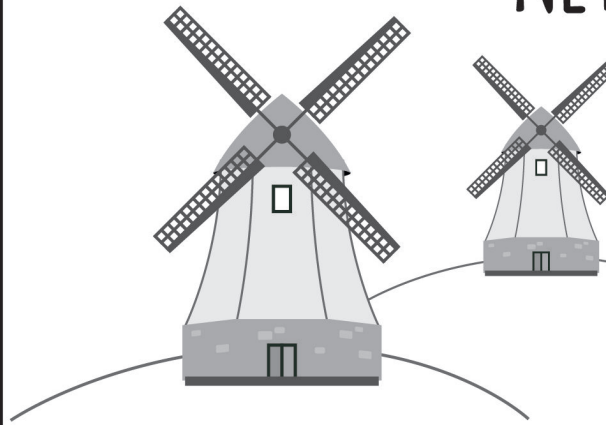
Color Netherlands in the map:

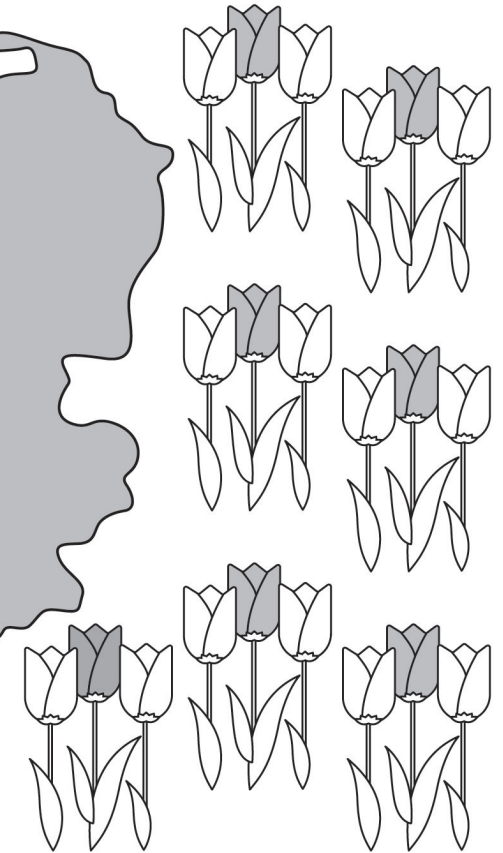
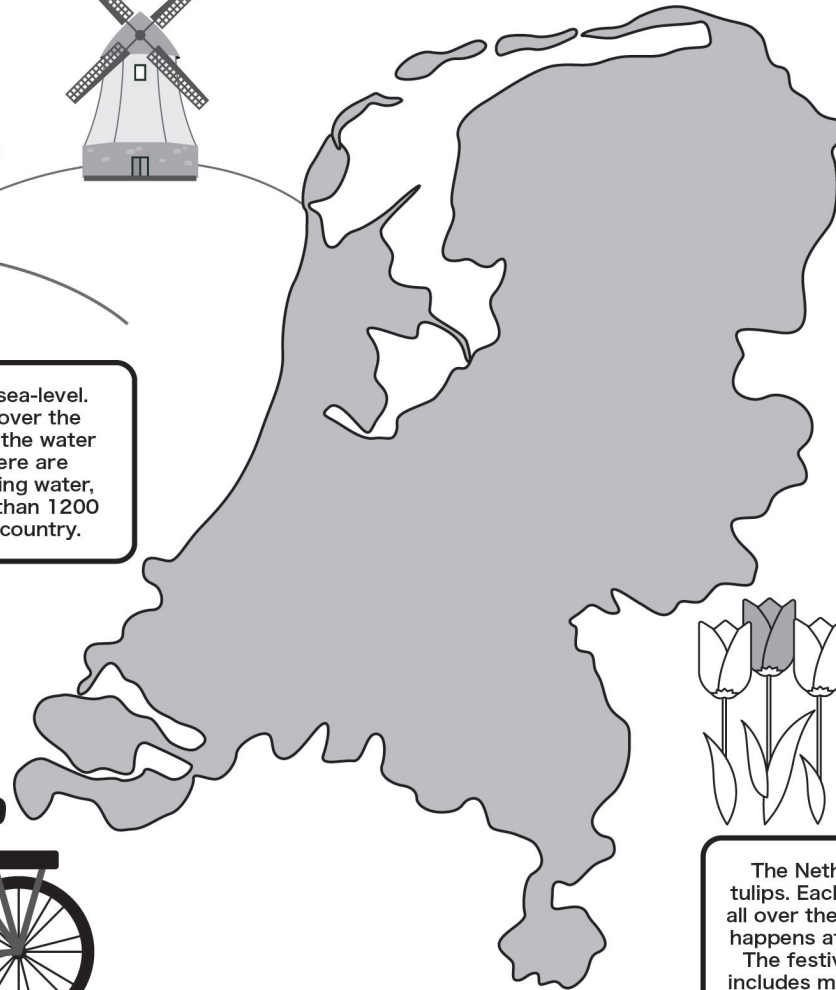
NETHERLANDS FUN FACTS
